<b>Framework goal:</b>	Determine the smallest organizational unit that has the ability to address an obstacle or risk, amplify a strength or validate a goal.
<b>Framework guidelines:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tailor the region names to represent the terminology of the company.</li> <li>2. Organize items into the best location.</li> </ol>
<b>Boundaries provided:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ideal number of participants of ~8 per forum (additional support staff to facilitate or capture information not included)</li> <li>2. Maximum time for each session of 60 minutes.</li> </ol>
<b>Resources used:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-person: Poster print of Cope of Control framework, Items printed on note cards, one per card, sharpies and tape.</li> <li>• Online: SAFe Collaborate (formerly Conteneo's Weave), Miro, or another online collaboration platform.</li> </ul>
